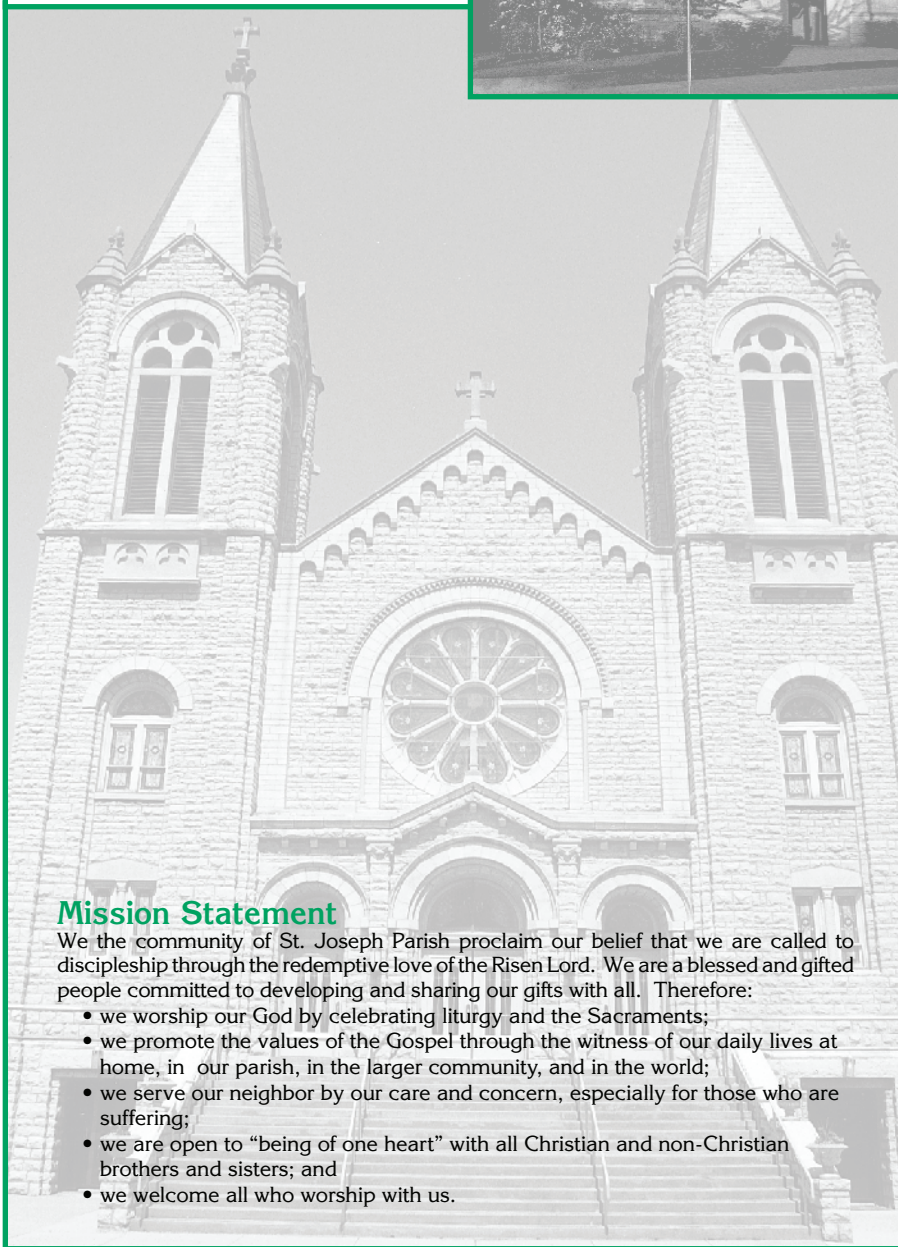

Ramblings from the Life Teen Department

Check out a teen's reflection on this weekend's Gospel (John 4:5-42)

This passage is a great example of the struggle to walk by faith and not by sight. For teens, this is pretty difficult when others are just starting to form their belief systems and they stray away from the word of God. In the passage, the woman is told about the living water, and even though she takes the term “living water” literally, she takes the leap of faith that most find hard. Teens find it difficult to take such leaps in their daily life, and this passage helps them see the rewards of doing so. Jesus talks about rewarding those who have done the work, and this is a concept that is hard to practice in daily life. With so many temptations to sin everyday, teens can find it difficult to make sure that they are doing the work required to achieve the ultimate goal in life, and this Gospel passage depicts the reward of the work.

SPOTLIGHT ON PENNY BIWER

Coordinator of Faith Formation for Adults and Grades 1-8

Say hello to Penny Biwer. Penny is in charge of the adult and grades 1-8 faith formation, and came to us from Stella Maris parish just five years ago in June. We asked Penny to tell us a little bit about her position here at St. Joseph. She told us as the Coordinator of Faith Formation, she assists in providing quality catecheses in the parish. Along with that, building community and focus on the family is very important in the vision of her ministry. Annually, opportunities such as the beginning of the year Family Mass/Ice Cream Social, Thanksgiving Mass/Potluck and added this year a Mardi Gras Celebration are provided for families to come together to learn and to celebrate being Catholic. Three times a year, faith formation classes are held for the Catechists, bringing the doctrines and traditions into their everyday life, and she also plans the weekly Bible study group, arranges for workshops, days of reflection, the adult summer speaker series, movie nights, Soups and Stations and this Lent plans to have the Renew small faith sharing groups meeting again.

Penny told us that the seeds of her faith were planted as a child, as her mother was very involved in the Lutheran Church. After being confirmed in the 8th grade Penny began teaching Sunday School. Later, she would marry and when their oldest daughter was in the 3rd grade, she would convert to the Catholic Faith, and join the family parish of St. Mary of the Lake in Baileys Harbor. Worshiping as a family and being a part of a parish family is very important to Penny. She quickly became very active in the parish life and was asked to become a catechist when their second daughter was in the First Communion class. This began her calling to the Faith Formation Ministry and after the parishes combined, she worked closely with her mentors Sr. Geri and Sr. Georgia, it was through their encouragement that she entered the Commissioned Ministry Leadership Program through the Diocese and was commissioned in Faith Formation three years ago. Five years ago, Deacon John Vincent, encouraged her to become the Faith Formation coordinator for St. Joseph and SS. Peter and Paul.

Penny works five days a week and also conducts the children's liturgy during the Sunday 10 a.m. Mass. She especially enjoys the Adult Bible study group, finding it a great opportunity for her to share and grow in her faith. Penny spends a lot of time researching new ideas and programs to improve the faith formation ministry.

Born and raised in West Jacksonport, she graduated from Sevastopol High School and has been married to Tim for 37 years, they live on the family farm in Fish Creek and have four children, Heather, Leah, Cole and Tanner and three grandchildren.

Penny enjoys meeting new people and her desire is to reach out to those who are searching for their faith and spirituality, to stir the faith in their hearts.

We thanked Penny for her dedication to the Faith Formation Ministry and all that she does to inspire our young children and the adults of our parish.
