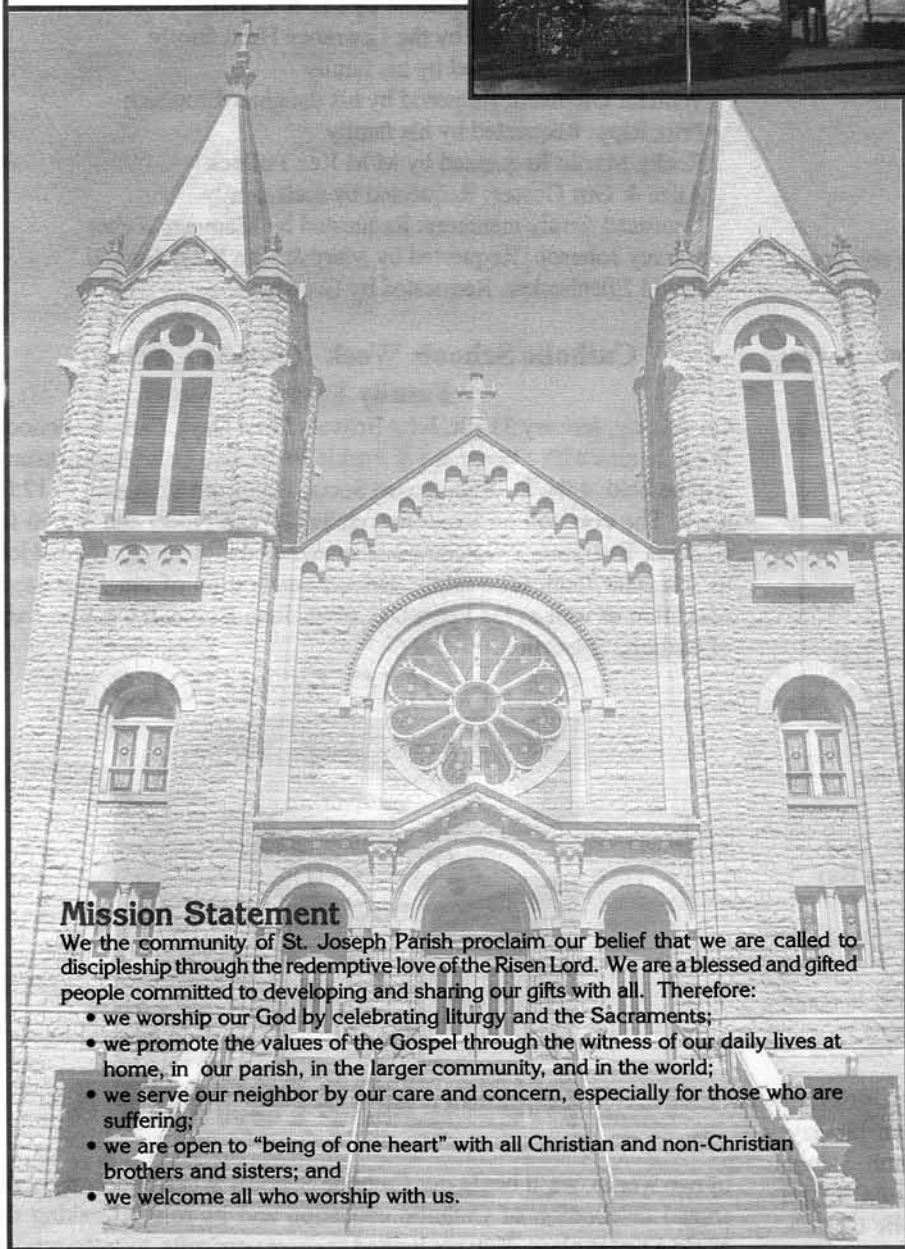
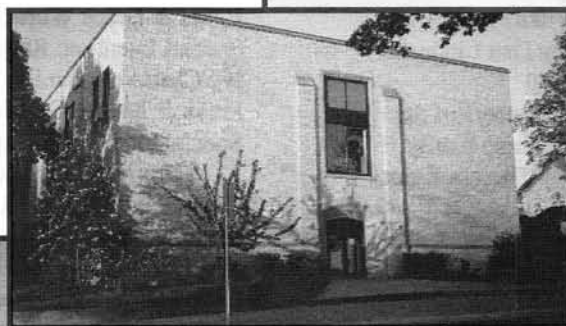

Haiti Collection

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops encouraged all dioceses to take up a special collection for the people and Church of Haiti. Although this second collection took place last weekend, we will still accept donations thru January 31st. Here is a short excerpt from a Catholic Relief Services report:

January 14, 2010 – *Even as Catholic Relief Services personnel in Haiti struggle to ensure that CRS' 300 staff members are safe and accounted for, they are beginning the work of bringing relief supplies to the millions affected by this week's earthquake. In the Dominican Republic, the country that shares the island of Hispaniola with Haiti, staff and volunteers are working on preparing food boxes loaded with sardines and peanut butter to feed 50,000 people. The first 500 are scheduled to be delivered to Port-au-Prince on Friday.*

It is gratifying to know that CRS is on the scene and doing what they can. CRS has committed an initial \$5 million to fund relief efforts which are likely to go on for some time. May God abundantly bless those who suffer in Haiti and those who are working to minister to their needs!
