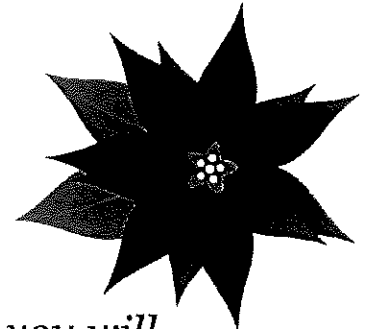
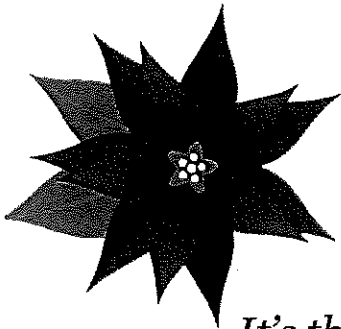
Confirmation class: Wed, November 15th from 7:30pm-9pm at Coupus Christi. All seniors are to park in the upper lot.
