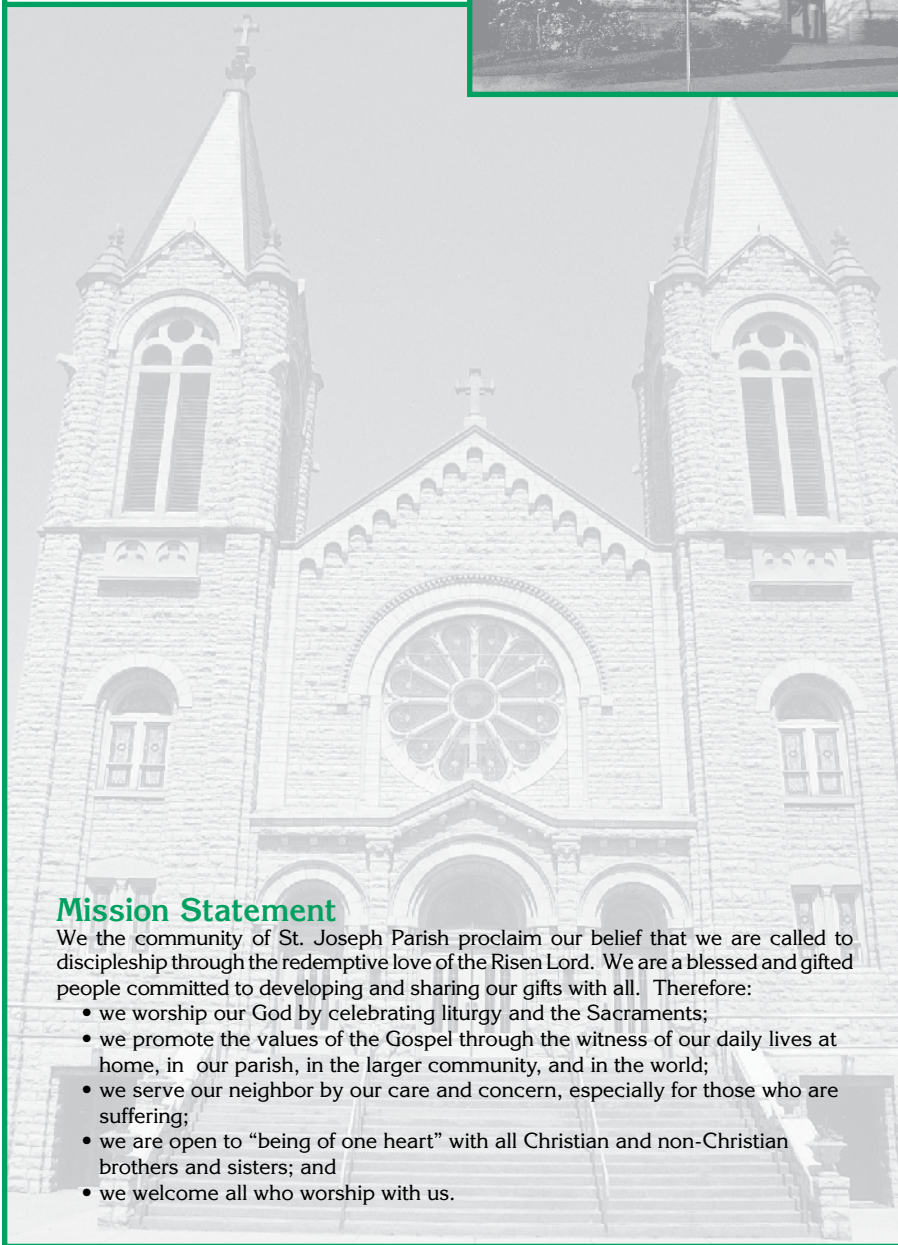

**St. Joseph Mass Televised**

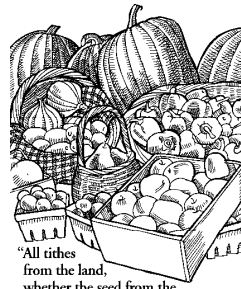
