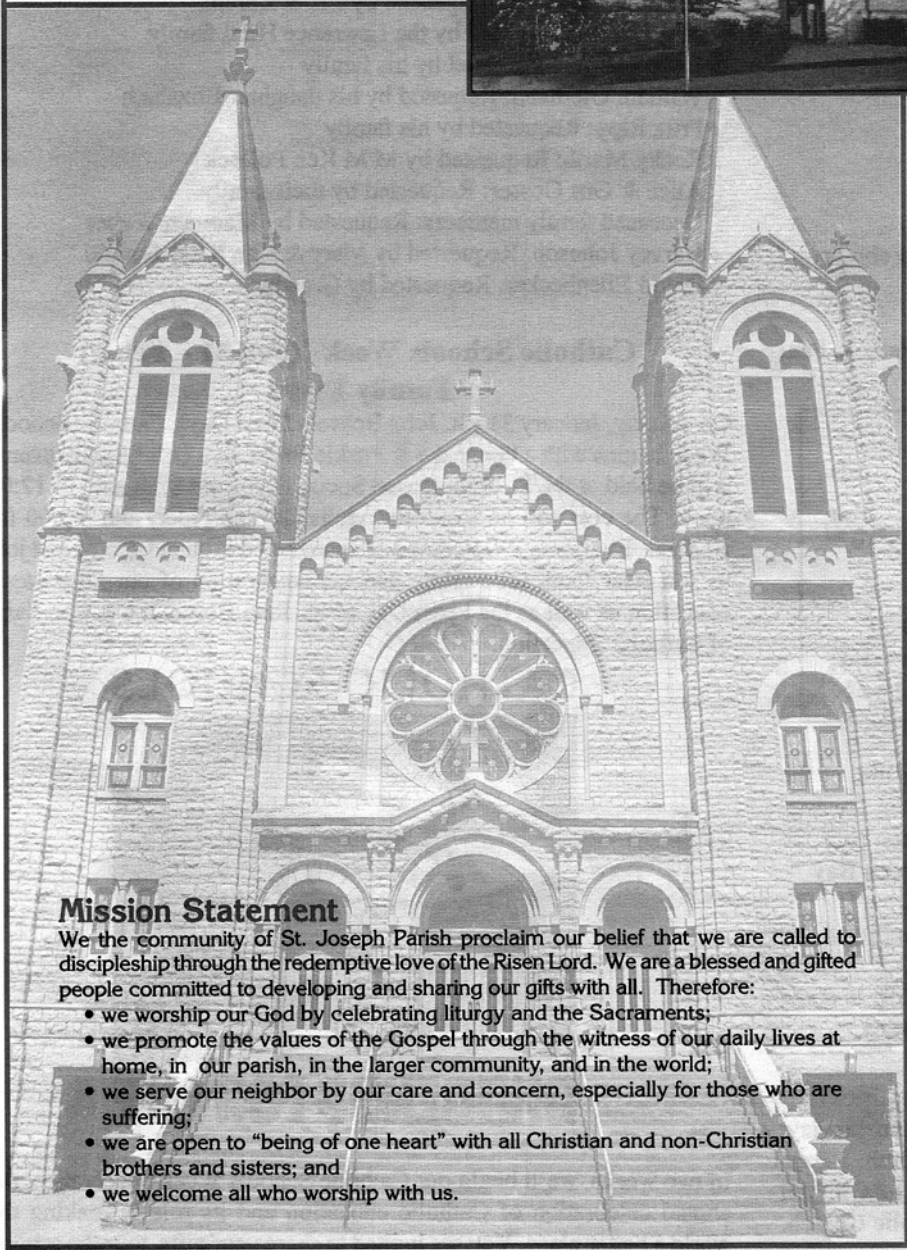
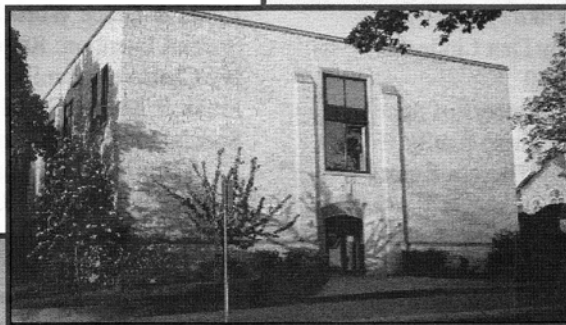

The transfiguration is a glimpse of future glory that will only come after the scandal of the cross. As Catholics we celebrate those glimpses in a very real way when God's grace enters our lives through the sacraments.
