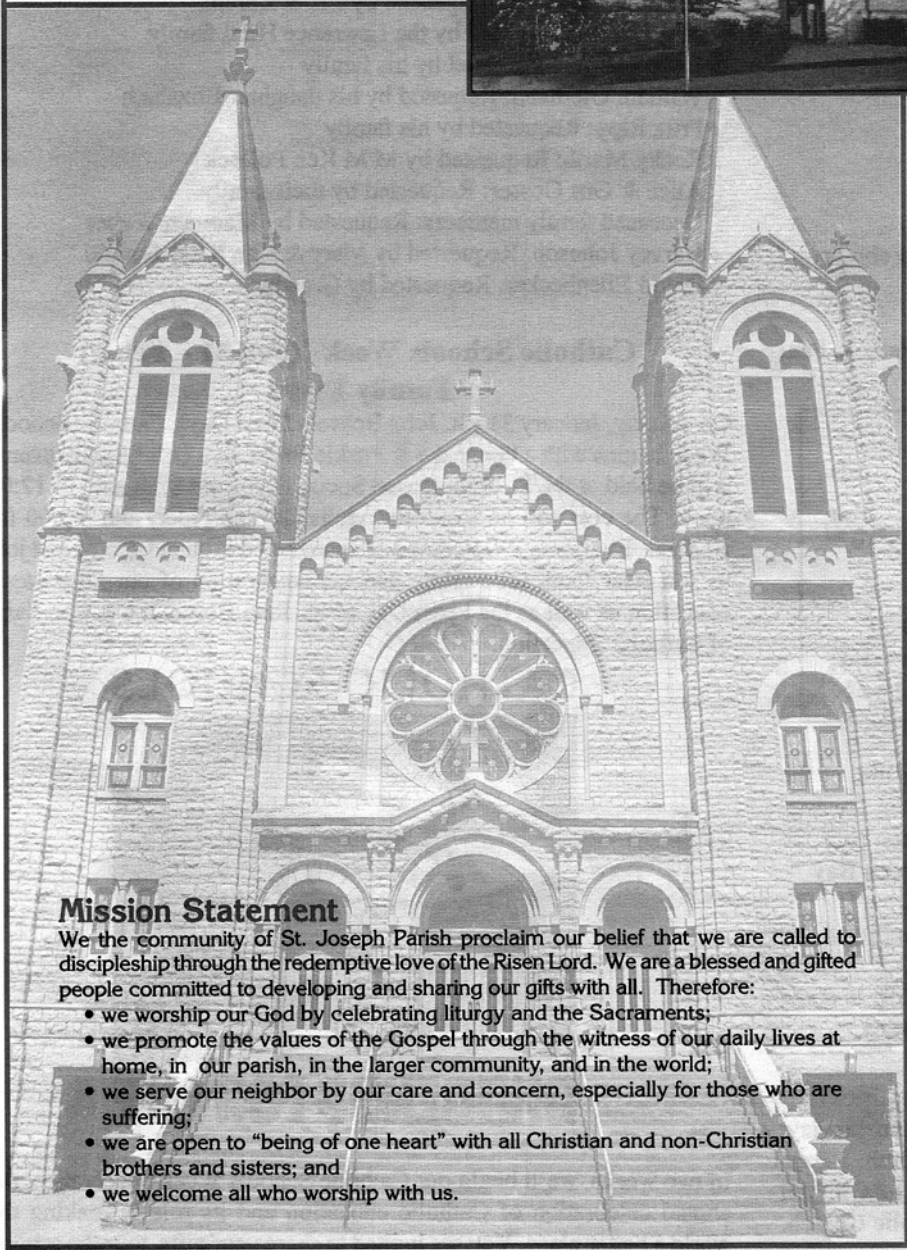
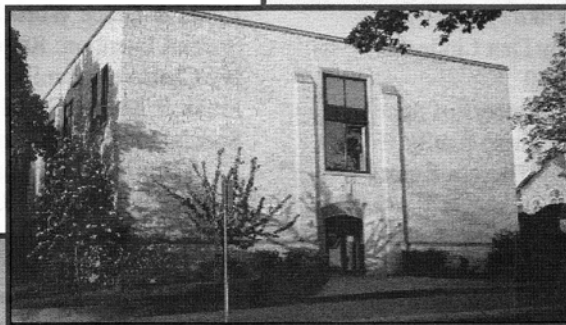

We won’t start reading the Passion until Ash Wednesday, when Lent actually begins. But we’ll start the six minute program on Sunday, Feb 14th (the Sunday before Ash Wednesday), which will give us three days to get ready for Lent. Look for them at all church entrances and in the parish office. A suggested \$1.00 donation would be greatly appreciated! Consider this an investment that will pay big returns.
