**Lenten Fast and Abstinence Rules**

Those who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent. Those who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast, that is one full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Two smaller meals are permitted on those two days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59<sup>th</sup> birthday. These practices are designed for spiritual growth. Ash Wednesday is February 14<sup>th</sup>, Good Friday is March 30<sup>th</sup> and Easter is April 1<sup>st</sup>.

## The Traditional Catholic Practice for Lent

**Prayer:** More intense personal and communal time with our God.

**Fasting:** In discovering our hunger, we find what we truly need.

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wed., all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday are to fast on Ash Wed. & Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may only eat one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
3. These minimal penitential practices should not be lightly excused.

**Almsgiving:** Giving of our goods and time in works of mercy and charity.
