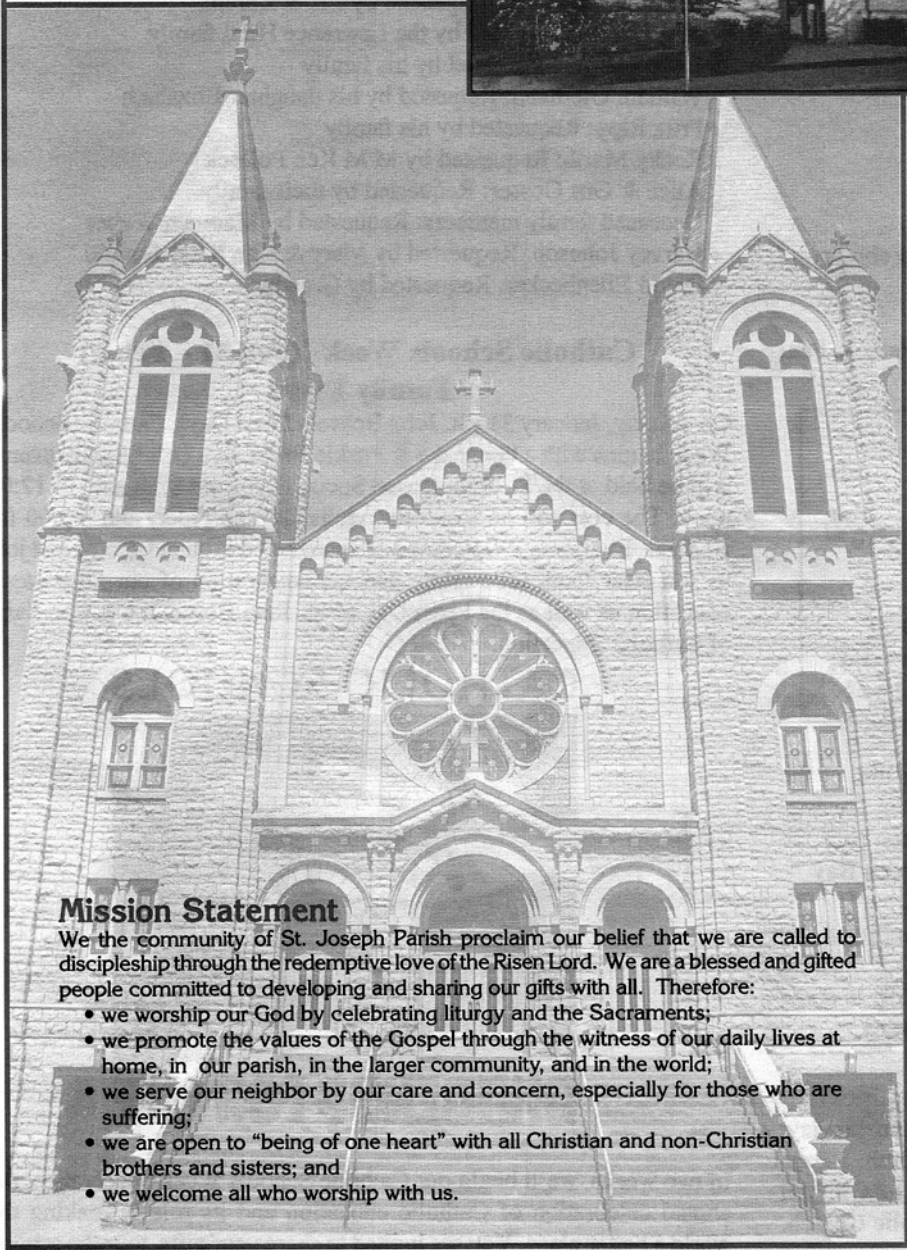
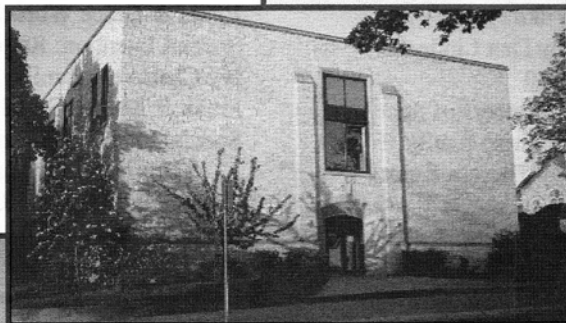

The common policy of the Catholic Diocese in Wisconsin requires a four month minimum notice before the date of marriage.

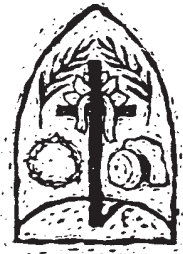

Parish Linkage

On Monday, March 1st, Mark Mogilka from the Green Bay diocese addressed Parish Council members, Finance Council members, Trustees, and staffs from Ss Peter & Paul and St. Joseph churches.

On the same evening he also addressed members from Corpus Christi parish.

The purpose of the meetings was to discuss and answer concerns regarding the 2004 pastoral plan which recommended that there be a linkage among the three parishes.

It is anticipated that another priest will be assigned to work with Fr. Carl. Hopefully, the Mass schedules will remain the same.

A Transition Task Force will be established with representatives from the three parishes to work out plans for the implementation of the linkage.
