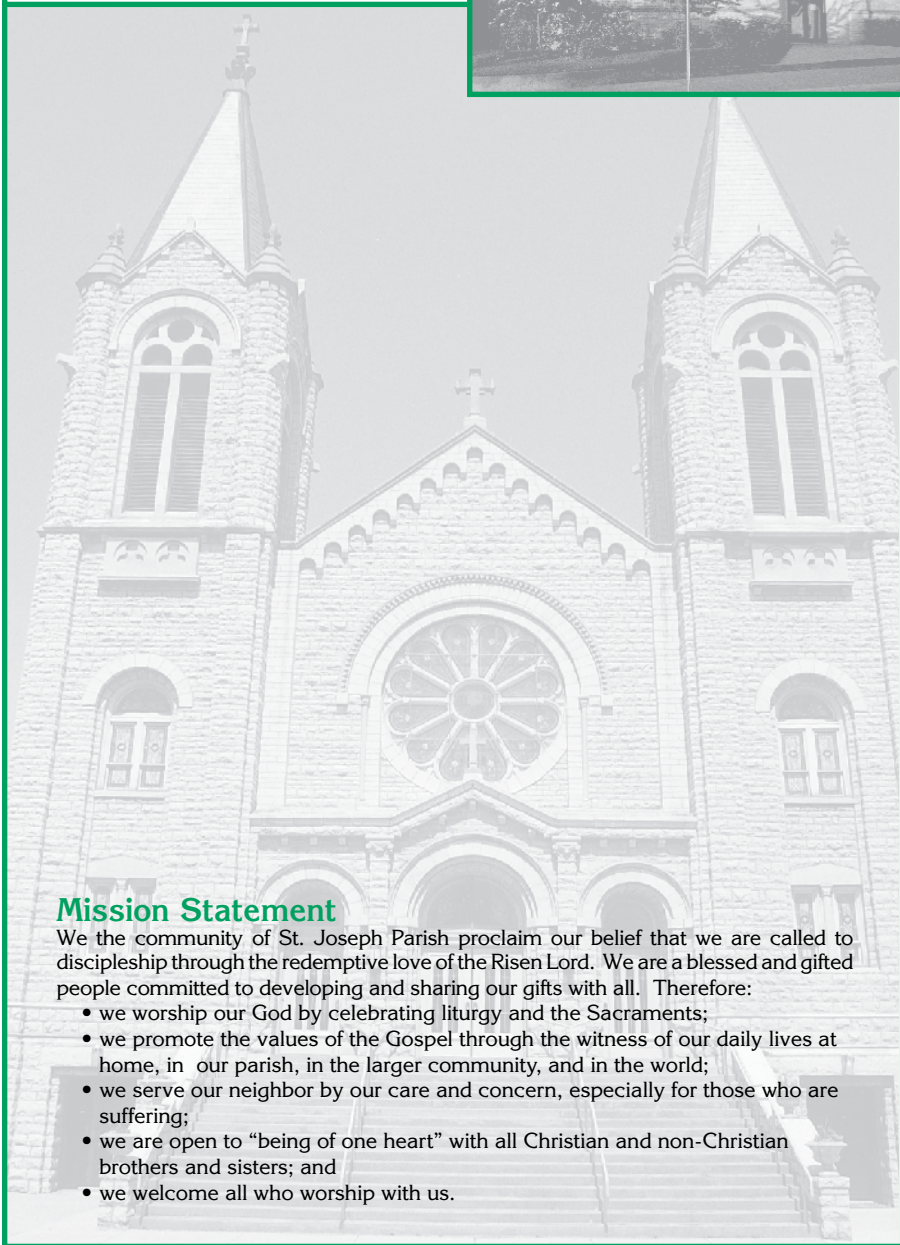

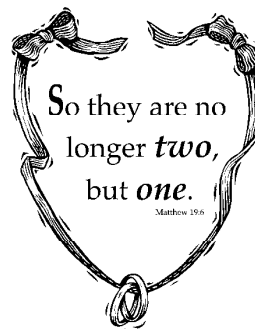

Ramblings from the Life Teen Department

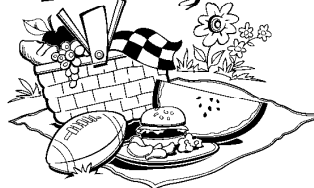
