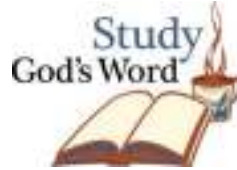


Cold and Flu Season
