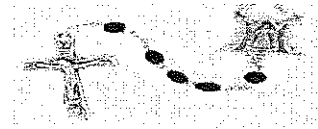

Known as the "Apostle of The Divine Mercy"

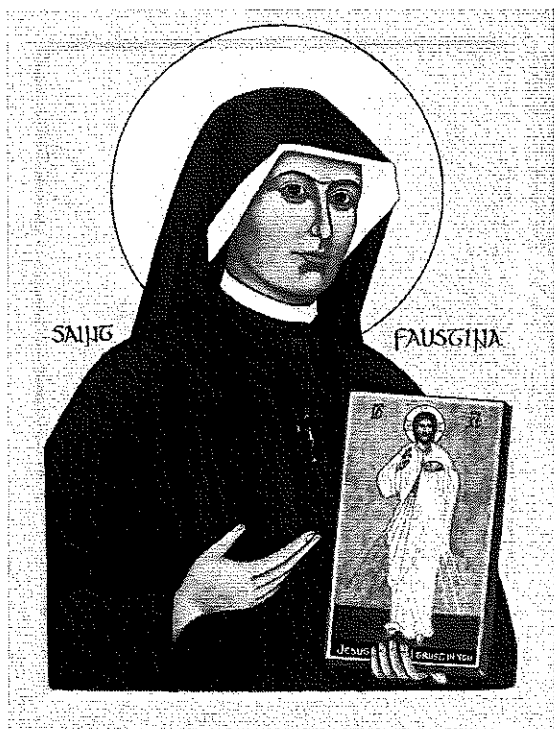


In October, 1937, in Cracow, the Lord Jesus recommended that she honor the hour of His death: "as often as you hear the clock strike the third hour, immerse yourself completely in My mercy, adoring and glorifying it: invoke its omnipotence for the whole world, and particularly for poor sinners: for at that moment mercy was opened wide for every soul" (Diary 1572).

\* The Lord Jesus promised: "In this hour you can obtain everything for yourself and others for the asking; it was the hour of grace for the whole world—mercy triumphed over justice" (Diary, 1572).

\* There are three conditions for prayers offered in this hour to be granted:

1. They are to be addressed to Jesus.
2. They are to be said at three o'clock in the afternoon.
3. They are to appeal to the value and merits of Christ's Passion

(Diary 1209) Jesus instructed me to write down and make before the Feast of Mercy, the Novena of Divine Mercy. It begins on Good Friday.

\* "I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever grace they need in the hardships of life, and especially at the hour of death."

\* "On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy, and I will bring these souls into the house of My Father."

Day 1: Good Friday, Bring me all mankind, especially all sinners

Day 2: Holy Saturday: Bring me the souls of priests and religious

Day 3: Easter: Bring to Me all devout and faithful souls

Day 4: Monday: Bring me pagans and those who do not know Me.

Day 5: Tuesday: Bring me souls of heretics and schismatics.

Day 6: Wednesday: Bring me meek and humble souls and souls of children.

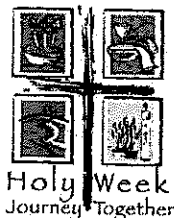
Day 7: Thursday: Bring me souls who especially venerate and glorify My mercy

Day 8: Friday: Bring me the souls who are in the prison of Purgatory

Day 9: Saturday: Bring me souls who have become lukewarm.

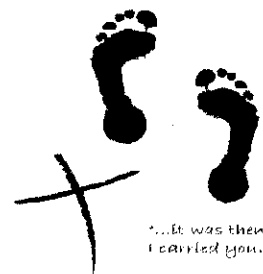

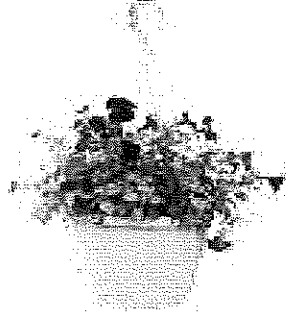
