Life Teen Mission Trip 2019 * * St. Louis

Dear parishioners,

1 in 3 people in St. Louis live in poverty. That is a shocking number. This summer, nearly 50 high schoolers and adults will be taking a journey to St. Louis to help those in need. Mission Camps are a unique summer camp experience focused on assisting communities in need through work projects and service, while growing in faith through prayer and evening sessions. Mission Camps include daily Mass, Reconciliation, Eucharistic Adoration, and other powerful prayer experiences.

Pope Francis recently said "Launch us on the adventure of helping the poor, those who feel lonely and abandoned, or no longer find meaning in their lives." We have a great group of young people who are ready to be launched to serve!

Mission trips are life changing because our youth are able to get away and truly disconnect from their busy lives (phones, internet, work, school, sports). When they disconnect and spend time in a new environment, their eyes are opened to the need around them. And guess what? **When their eyes are opened they can't be closed.** Students who attend mission trips are more likely to serve locally here in Door County.



