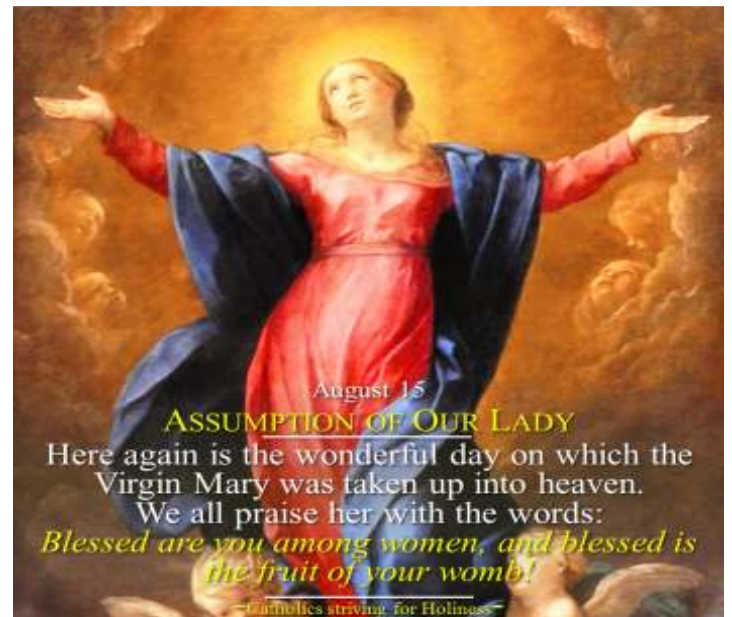
The August tabernacle candle is lit in loving memory of mother, Lillian and son, Chad Gauger.
