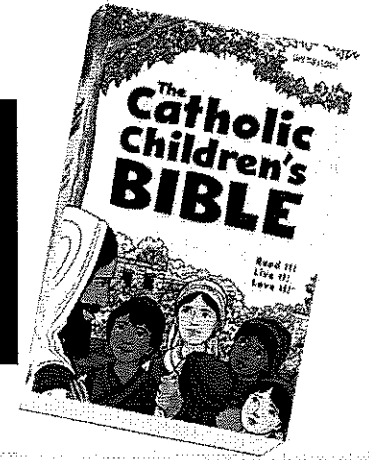
Knights of Columbus Council 2478 of Sturgeon Bay Family of the Month


