From the "Diary of Sister Maria Faustina Kowalska"

The Feast of The Divine Mercy ranks highest among all the elements of the Divine Mercy Devotion revealed to Sister Faustina, for He was communicating His will regarding the painting of the Image: "I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy" (Diary, 49)

- The Lord Jesus said, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners" (Diary, 699). "Souls perish in spite of My bitter Passion. I am giving them the last hope of salvation, that is, recourse to My Mercy. If they will not adore My mercy, they will perish for all eternity" (Diary, 965, 998)

- "...whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment" (Diary, 300), and also, "On this day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy....Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet: (Diary, 699)..."on that day, priests are to tell everyone about My great and unfathomable mercy" (Diary, 570).
