Mission Statement

Believing that faith formation is at the core of the Church the Center of Faith Formation at Saint Joseph Parish exists as a beacon to enrich the spiritual life and formation of disciples of all ages within our ecumenical community.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus



One of the most popular images of Jesus in Catholic churches and homes is the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In this image, God’s love is revealed in the pierced heart of His Son, a symbol of the One who loved us to the end, a love that conquers sin and transcends death.

Since the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, from his Sacred Heart, this should have great meaning for us.

- In prayer, we contemplate the pierced Heart of our Savior and learn how to live from His incredible love, mercy, compassion and humility.
- In our lives and in our work in the Church, we must place all our hope in his redeeming love and proclaim it to the world. Our goal is to lead people to encounter this love, the only love that can transform the human heart and bring true peace.

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Friday after the Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ. The Eucharist has been called “the outstanding gift of the Heart of Jesus: the Heart that gives life to the Church and to all of us, her members.

Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto thine.



The Immaculate Heart of Mary

The Immaculate Heart of Mary is a devotional name used to refer to the interior life of the Blessed Virgin Mary, her joys and sorrows, her virtues and perfections, her love for God, and her Divine Son and her compassionate love for mankind.

Symbolism of the image

- First of all Mary’s heart is visible outside of her body. This points to her undying love for all people. Her love is such that she can not contain it within.
- Secondly, her heart is typically on fire, which emphasizes the intensity of her love for God and for humanity.
- Next there are white roses that encircle her heart. These symbolize her purity, brought about by her Immaculate Conception, creating within her a most pure heart.
- A single sword is sometimes added going through her heart, referring to the passage of Luke (“a sword shall pierce...”) and brings to mind the sorrows she endured during her lifetime, especially during the crucifixion.
- Last of all, the heart is typically surrounded by rays of light. This brings to mind Revelation 12:1, where it describes the Blessed Virgin Mary as “a woman clothed with the sun.”
