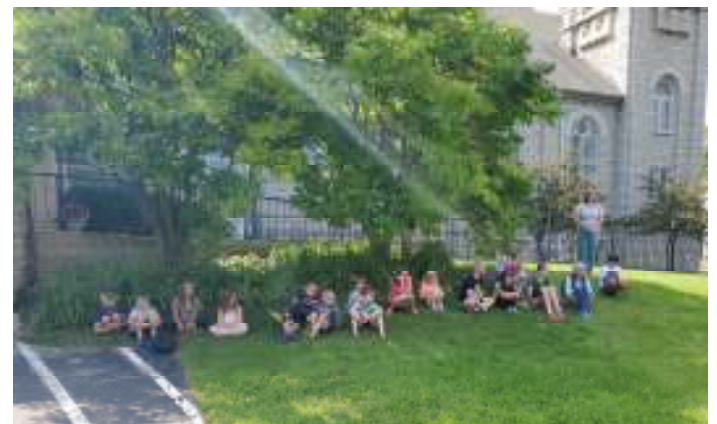
From the Bishop's Corner



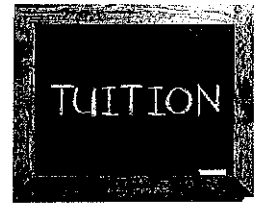


Reading Assessment Day
